WHY JELICO?

World Servants partners with Good Soil Ministries in Jellico, Tennessee and has been invited to assist with a variety of projects. Many of the community members live in mobile home trailer that are in need of significant upkeep. Through serving a local family you will have the opportunity to build a loving relationship, learning all about their life stories. Many people in the Appalachia mountains live fairly secluded, lonely lives and are quite shy. Through developing relationships you will earn the right to share your own story and the significance of faith in Christ in your life. In addition, to construction projects you will help with Kids' Club or similar type of ministry program that reaches out to the children and youth of the community. With your help and Good Soil, we also have Life Skill seminars for people of all ages. WHAT DOES THE TRIP COST?

The total cost for the trip is \$625 per person. This cost covers: lodging, food, and the costs to supply the project. This does NOT include money for lunch on the scheduled day off or activities you may pursue on that day. It also does NOT include transportation. Once we have our team members in place we will coordinate carpooling options to Jellico and during the week. Children ages 5-7 are able to attend at a discounted price of \$262.50.

WHAT IS INVOLVED IN GOING?

This trip is not typical of most Northview trips. This trip does NOT require participants to attend pre-trip meetings. You will need to complete an application through Northview and you will be required to make a \$100 non-refundable deposit.

FOOD & HOUSING?

You should expect your housing to be on the floor of a church, school or community center. The team may be asked to assist in the preparation of meals depending on the housing location (to be determined). Lunches will be packed and taken to the worksites with you each day.
